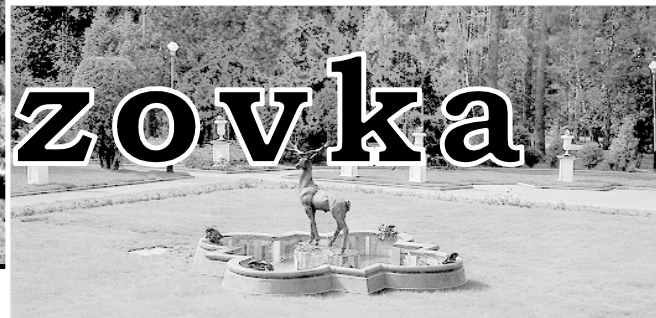

Morozovka

150 acres of paradise near Moscow built for Stalin!

THIS OLD ESTATE was refurbished after World War II to become a country residence for Stalin. The palace was re-designed in the traditions of post-war Retro-Classics. A team of the best architects and decorators of the day had virtually unlimited financing. They used the choicest materials, finest furniture and superb pieces of art. When the place was finished in 1953, Stalin died.

The estate was then used for receptions of heads of governments and other V.I.P. guests.



In 1994 the estate was bought by Gazprom, Russia's gas giant. The palace was renovated, the furniture and art collections were restored by Italian experts.

The designers have somehow managed to endow the place with the warm atmosphere of a lived-in house.



The palace intrigues people. They roam about from hall to hall, seat in upholstered chairs, themselves pieces of art, admire beautiful frescoes, precious Gobelin tapestries or Italian marble heads, make music and relax.

Guest house

The estate has a unique wooden guest house with a sauna, a Greek therm, and a turbo-pool.



Beautiful grounds

The old beautiful Russian-style park with serene ponds was designed in 1906 by Regel, the then director of the Botanical Gardens

of Moscow University. There are up to 60 species of rare trees and shrubs in the park.

The park has regular areas with flowers, rotundas, bronze deer figures, fountains, etc.

The air of Morozovka is special. The aroma of the huge park is intoxicating. In the park, every turn of the trail will present you with a breath-taking scene of Central Russian gently sloping country-side.

This all creates a private, comfortable, quiet, and carefree mood for relaxing with family, friends... and horses.
